BBQ & Concert Areas:

The concert and food sales will be held on **Apex Oval**.

Access to toilets will be the public toilets adjacent to Apex.

Please note to ensure all people can view the concert there are set areas for people to sit on picnic rugs and for people to sit in chairs.

Reminders:

- The community BBQ will start at 4:30pm.
- Rubbish bins will be provided on Apex oval.
- We ask that no picnic rugs or deck chairs are to be pegged into the oval surface due to the underground watering systems.
- No alcohol or dogs are allowed at the concert.
- Your child needs to be seated with their teacher by **5:45pm** in the designated student area in front of the stage. They stay with their teacher for the duration of the concert.
- We ask that all children are taken to the toilet prior to coming to sit with their teacher.
- It is an expectation that children stay with their teacher for the duration of the concert. Unless previously arranged with Allyson Armstrong, children will not be released to go home early.
- Parents and siblings **are not** permitted to sit in the designated student area as we need to move students on and off the stage quickly.
- Please do not interrupt the concert by walking through the designated student area to request to take your students home early as this impacts the filming of the concert.
- At the end of the concert you will need to collect your child from their classroom teacher.
- We have arranged for the concert to be filmed. The videographers will have a designated filming area and we ask that members of the community stay away from this space.
