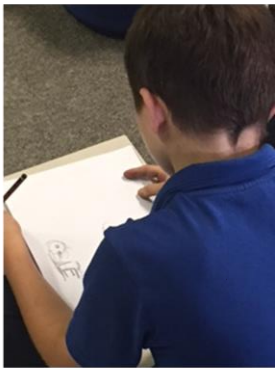

In line with our Sun Smart policy, please remember that Term 4 means 'no hat no play'. Students need to bring their hat every day.

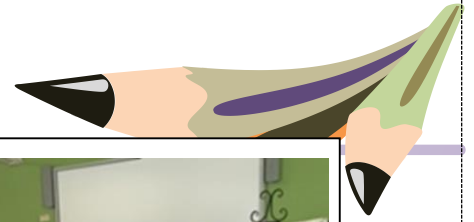
